QFT

Step 1

Produce your own questions

Ask as many questions as you can.

- Do not stop to discuss, judge, or answer the questions.
- Write down every question exactly as it is stated.
- Change any statement into a question.

Step 2

Improve your questions

- Categorise the questions as closed or open-ended.
- Name the advantages and disadvantages of each type of question.
- Change questions from one type to another.

Step 3

Prioritise your questions

- Choose your three most important questions.
- Why did you choose these three as the most important?

Step 4

Next steps?

- How are you going to use your questions?
- How could it make us learn more?
- How could it make us learn better?

Step 5

Reflect

- Reflect on how you have learnt.
- How has QFT contributed to your thinking and learning?
- Can you apply this to other settings?
